

ROLES FOR THE MYSTERY SKYPE CALL

Greeter/closer - 1 student- Welcomes other class with a greeting (don't say our location!) and going over rules. At the end of the call, also say "thank you" and facilitate a quick exchange, if there's time! In between, please assist others as needed.

Questioners - 2 students - Ask the yes or no questions, based on input from the runner.

Answerer - 1 student - Answers yes or no to the questions and should have a good grasp of geography.

Runner - 1 student- Responsible for communication between the different roles. Make sure to communicate next question to the questioners ASAP!

Google Mappers and researchers - 2 students - Use Google Maps/search to try to help with questions or find the answer.

Atlas mappers - 2 students -Try to help with questions/find location.

Supervisor - 1 student- This student oversees the entire operation and takes notes on what works and doesn't work. They lead the debriefing after every Skype call to discuss what we need to work on and what we should be proud of.

Note taker - 2 students- Write down all answers and questions during the call.

Social Media - 2 students- Adds the extra layer of connectivity to the world. Takes pictures and notes throughout the call to share online and writes a brief post on our classroom blog after the call is done.
